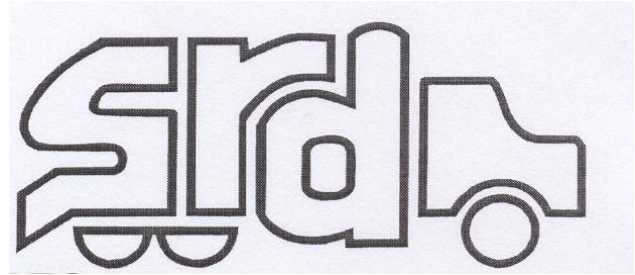

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING



Additional information to answer frequently asked questions. Feel free to call our office if you have additional questions. (Stutzman Refuse, 800-230-0383.) We appreciate your support and your efforts on this updated single stream recycling for Park City.

Cart Placement—This new style of Cart will be serviced with automated trucks. It is important to have the Cart set out in an area that is free and clear of cars, poles, trees and any object that could keep the truck from reaching the Cart. This location should be within 2 feet of the curb. See the additional enclosure for helpful hints.

No more bags on the curb—The cart will replace bags—no more pickup of recycle bags at the curb.

Every other week Single Stream Recycling — Single stream makes recycling easy! Just place all your recycle materials you have unsorted loose in the provided cart. Place it on the curb on pickup day and we do the rest in our updated high tech single stream processing plant where all the materials are sorted for market with the latest in technology recycling equipment.

As a reminder you can participate with the City's preferred discount trash provider and be billed on with the City utilities.

Recycling is available to every single residential family dwelling in Park City.

Materials you can place loose in your recycling cart!

- Aluminum ,& steel (tin) beverage & food cans
- Plastic beverage, food, & soap containers (#1 thru #7)
- Glass containers (all colors of food & beverage jars & bottles)
- Newspapers (including inserts)
- Magazines, junk mail, office paper, books, phone books, catalogs
- Cardboard & pasteboard

Cart Placement

Cart placement is important for automated services. The Cart should be placed within 2 feet of the curb in an area that is free from cars, trees & poles. The truck arm will reach the Cart, dump & return the Cart to the pick up location. Please do not strap or tie the lids down.



The Cart should be placed with the lid opening toward the street & out for pick up by 7:00 a.m.
